
At Tenbroeck Academy a child engages with the arts every day of the week. Our curriculum is carefully curated and crafted in collaboration with artist facilitators and a curation team, keeping in mind the varied and growing needs of children, aimed at making it a wholesome experience for each child. The program focuses on exposure

to different forms of art thus giving them an opportunity to develop multiple intelligences and skill sets. Our arts facilitators are accomplished performers and teachers and are best equipped to facilitate a creative, artistic and meaningful exchange in the different art forms.

AFTER SCHOOL

We intend to facilitate specialization programs in arts and sports within the campus after the school hours. This will be an intense and comprehensive program focused on rigorous training and skill-building to help the children practice and pursue their preferred choice of art or sport in an in-depth manner. This will also promote interaction of children with the community, thus enabling them to learn and grow into talented young artists and change makers.





Indian Certificate of Secondary

Education (ICSE) curriculum involves a structured syllabus focused on concepts for wide and in-depth learning. It also offers equal weightage to languages, sciences, arts and humanities allowing for a balanced, wholesome and inclusive education. The structure of the ICSE syllabus requires children to look beyond textbooks, venture into labs and gather hands-on experience to get a

At Tenbroeck Academy a conscious attempt has been made to look at quality content over quantity. This means that children are encouraged to

diversify their interests and develop a curious, questioning and analytical approach. Rather than a one-way transfer of information, our methodology is based on an all-around and experiential system of learning. All the ICSE sections will have a student to adult "in class" ratio of 35:1 and an overall student to adult ratio of 15:1. The environments provide the infrastructure and atmosphere that nurtures learning, makes children confident, increases their quest for knowledge and prepares them to appear for exams to use their potential to the fullest.

Thus, we ensure the ICSE curriculum offers an elevated quality of education by giving the children a strong foundation for whatever career option they may choose and prepare them for life.

ELEMENTARY MONTESSORI

Elementary children are driven by natural curiosity to figure out the interconnectedness of the world around and their place in the world. Our education sparks excitement, enthusiasm and wonder in a child and is not just about math, grammar, and science. Dr. Maria Montessori used the term "cosmic education" to refer to this education that helps the children come to understand their role in the world, their potential, and the nature of their own "cosmic task." Peace and gratitude are consistent themes in the cosmic education curriculum. Dr. Maria Montessori believed that the way to restore order and harmony in the world was through the education of the child.

Our Elementary Montessori program serves children aged between 6 to 12 years where students of grades 1, 2, and 3, work together as a mixed age group in one environment. We maintain a student: adult ratio of 15:1 in all the Montessori Environments. Timelines, charts, and research cards of human needs help the child in independent study and inspire more research in geology, sciences, biology, geography and history. The children use their imagination and reasoning minds to explore all the parts of the universe and are engaged in a variety of experiment based learning activities alongside.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Tenbroeck Academy is a modern establishment located in Basavanagudi. The facility is spread across 70,000 sft. area with a beautiful 300 seating capacity amphitheatre intended to be the hub for cultural activities. The Academy has 13,000sft. area of dedicated activity space for the creative development of children. It is an ideal place for school programs, workshops and guest talks. We also have 11000 sft area for football, 2 cricket pitches, half Olympic size length swimming pool, 3000 sft. space for strength and conditioning, 2 Basketball 3*3 courts, 40 meters running tracks.

Children have access to all state-of-the-art facilities like laboratories and computing facilities that are required to support and enhance their learning. The well-stocked library encourages reading and research habits. We also have equipped studios for learning music, dance and arts. The school also has allocated spaces for counselling, storage and an infirmary. The classrooms are spacious with natural ventilation and light. Technology is integrated into daily work at individual and collaborative levels.
